

Materials

Yarn 5mm Crochet Hook Scissors Yarn needle Stitch Marker (optional)

Abbreviations

CH - Chain SC - Single Crochet BLO - Back Loop Only SS - Slip Stitch



Note

- There are many great tutorials on how to complete the above stitches online.
- If you feel like your hat is too small/large simply increase/decrease the no of initial chains and subsequent rows.
- Use a stitch marker to mark the 1st stitch of each row.
- The rectangle should be approx 40cm x 22cm

Pattern

CH 35

Row 1: SC in the 2nd CH from the hook and in each CH across - total 34

Row 2: CH 1 and turn. SC in BLO of each stitch across until you reach your last stitch - total 34

Row 3-68: Same as Row 2. Fasten off and leave a long tail (long piece of yarn)

- You should end up with a rectangle, approx 40cm x 22cm.Fold the rectangle in half so the 1st and last Row are lined up.
- Seam the 2 sides together using a yarn needle OR SS both sides using your crochet hook.
- once you reach the end, using a yarn needle, stitch along the top of the rectangle by weaving your needle in and out of the stitches.
- Pull the yarn tight to gather up the top of your hat. Sew a few stitches, closing up the hole, fasten off and weave in your yarn to make it nice and secure.
- Turn your hat inside out and fold up the brim.
- Add a fluffy Pom Pom (Optional)





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
