



SIMPLE KNITTED BEANIE

Materials

Medium weight yarn
Size 8 (5 mm) needles
Yarn needle

Abbreviations

k - knit
p - purl

Note

This is a very basic k1-p1 ribbed hat. This pattern is written to be knitted flat and seamed.

The circumferences are given for the hat un-stretched. It is a very stretchy hat.

<u>Size</u>	<u>Circumference</u> <i>(Inches)</i>	<u>Height of hat</u> <i>(Inches)</i>	<u>Ounces of yarn</u>
Newborn	8.75	6.25	1.02
6 months	9.75	6.75	1.24
12 months	10.5	7.5	1.47
Toddler	11.5	8.0	1.73
Child	12.25	8.75	2.01
Teen	13.25	9.25	2.3

Gauge: 17 stitches and 23 rows = 4 inches in stockinette

Pattern

Amount to cast on for the different sizes:

Newborn = 61
6 months = 67
12 months = 73
Toddler = 79
Child = 85
Teen = 91

Repeat instructions between * across the row.

Instructions:

Row 1: * k1, p1 *, k1
Row 2: p1, * k1, p1 *


- Continue this ribbing pattern until the hat measures the height of the hat in the above table.
- Cast off loosely, leaving a long tail of yarn.
- Thread the tail through the cast off row and pull to gather tightly. Knot securely, then use tail to seam the side.
- FINISHING Make a pom-pom. Tie pom-pom to top of Hat.



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
